#### PATIO HOMES BOARD UPDATE:

Patio Homes Weekly Curbside Trash Removal: The Clearwater Sanitation Dept. collects garbage, recyclables, yard waste and household trash weekly on Monday mornings. For garbage (black barrel), recyclables (blue barrel), and other waste items, please DO NOT put to the curb any earlier than 7 p.m. on the night prior (Sunday night) to your collection day (Monday). The exception is yard waste, which can be put out early on Sunday. Tree limbs and shrubs must be cut into 4 ft. lengths and placed curbside. Your contracted tree service companies must take away their own cuttings. Please remember to clean up the curb area after the collection, and take your barrels in.
